

Overnight Schedule and Activity Description

Please note, the schedule is subject to changes due to varying factors such as group arrival time and weather.

6:00 PM	Assembly on the Pier and Briefing Group will assemble on Pier V in Baltimore's Inner Harbor and meet the lead educator who will brief participants about safety and teach youth how to "toe-the-line", or fall-in for muster.
6:00 PM	Gear Stowage Participants will board the ship and stow their gear.
6:15 PM	Tour Part I. The ship's tour is broken into two segments, the first focuses on the outer characteristics of the ship and ends in the Bridge.
6:45 PM	Hands-On Activity- "Damage Control Stations!" Using their new knowledge of the ship, campers will use problem solving skills to assess situations such as an electrical fires and flooding compartments with team work and sound powered telephones.
7:15 PM	Evening Snack Pizza was traditionally served aboard this ship by the officers on Fridays to help morale.
8:00 PM	Tour Part II The second part of the tour focuses on the ship's interior.
8:30 PM	Hands-On Activity- "Plane Spotting!" Overnight participants learn how military and civilians identified planes during WWII. Participants will identify Japanese and American planes, including ones Taney is credited with downing during her career.
09:00 PM	General Quarters Drill In the military the General Quarters (GQ) shipboard condition involves every member of a military ship's personnel having a specific job and post assigned to them during circumstances of imminent danger or battle. This activity simulates the unpredictability, haste, and stress of getting to one's post at the sudden and unexpected call to GQ.
9:15 PM	Preparation for Lights Out
10:00 PM	Lights Out; Begin Night Watch.
07:00 AM	Reveille Wake and pack gear.
07:30 AM	Breakfast
08:00AM	Hands-on Activity: "All Ahead Full!" Overnight participants explore where no daytime visitor gets to go, the Engine Room! Here, participants learn how steam powers the Taney's engines and other systems as well as participate in a science experiment using a Hero's Engine.
08:30 AM	Hands-on Activity: "Fire Support!" Participants explore and learn how crew manned the ship's 5"-38 gun.
09:00 AM	Debriefing and Departure Overnight groups are welcome to tour our other ships after 1000am opening.
